8 en-suite bathrooms for hospital ward allocated for the care of patients with infectious diseases (e.g. TB).

Multiple user scenario with varying degrees of independence/dependence

Young adults to elderly

Various mobility aids including mobile hoists

Pressalit Cares solution:

- Track mounted, electrically assisted basin
- Tap with long spout and lever
- Track mounted, height adjustable toilet support arms
- Track mounted, 410 shower chair
- Shower taps on track mounted bracket
- Vertical grab rail with showerhead holder and showerhead

Effect

The bathrooms are adjustable to meet different user requirements.

The corner placed shower allows left- or right-sided independent/dependent use.

Peninsular location of toilet allows left- and right-sided access.

Hand washing within reach of the toilet by means of movable basin.

Environment easier to clean as shower seat, basin etc. can be moved or removed.
